

How to use the Maintenance Page

On the Chapter Z webpage you can now keep track of the maintenance of your motorcycle. You can track as many motorcycles as you need to. You will use your GWRRA# as your logon. Co-riders will add "01" at the end of their number. Those of you with multiple motorcycles can add "02", "03", etc. for each motorcycle. Instructions for the multiple screens are below.

There are Four different areas to go to:

1. First Time Users
2. Update Mileage
3. View Maintenance Log
4. Update Maintenance Log

FIRST TIME USERS

This form is at the bottom and you will only use this once to get your information entered into the database.

You will enter your GWRRA# and then set up a password (you'll need to re-enter it to verify). Then fill in the pertinent information (start date is either January 1st of the current year, or the date you purchased your new motorcycle of the current year). Then put the odometer reading for each item you want to track (e.g.; let's say you put in a new air filter at 12,345 miles. You would enter 12345 in the air filter field). Also put down how often you change your oil (e.g.; every 2,500, 5,000, 6,000, etc.). The "Do you want

your mileage shared?" will determine if your mileage information will be displayed on the mileage page for everyone to see (the educator will have access to this data no matter what).

YOU WILL NEED TO FILL THIS OUT FOR EACH MOTORCYCLE YOU HAVE. Co-riders that ride their own motorcycle will need to fill this out as well (add "01" to their GWRRA#).

UPDATE MILEAGE

This form will reset your current mileage, so that it calculates total miles this year, average miles per day, how many miles you have on tires, brakes, filters, etc. Enter the GWRRA# for that motorcycle, password, and current odometer reading. This is the form you'll use most often (that is why it is at the top).

VIEW MAINTENANCE LOG

This is the form you'll want to go to in order to see the maintenance log of your motorcycle. Enter the GWRRA# for that motorcycle, and password.
